Use this guide to identify ideal patients for Pocket-X® Gel as an adjunct to non-surgical periodontal therapy.

Ideal Patient Candidates

- Adults with diagnosed periodontitis
 Especially Stage 2–3 periodontitis where pockets remain after SRP Pockets ≥ 5 mm with bleeding on probing
- Patients scheduled for non-surgical periodontal therapy (RSD/SRP)
 Best placed at the end of hygienist sessions
- Patients showing inflammation despite maintenance
 Red/swollen gums, Bleeding on brushing or probing, Chewing discomfort, Bad
 taste/halitosis
- Patients motivated for gum health
 Likely to comply with aftercare (no eating/rinsing immediately, gentle brushing, avoiding interdental cleaning for 2 days)
- Patients wishing to avoid or delay surgery
 Suitable for conservative treatment with less discomfort

X Exclusion Criteria

- Known allergy to hyaluronic acid, octenidine, phenoxyethanol, or poloxamer.
- Pregnant or breastfeeding women.
- Children or adolescents
- Patients unable to follow aftercare instructions.
